

**RADIATION SAFETY ACT****CONDITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS (SECTION 36)****LASERS – SALE, SERVICE, MAINTENANCE AND TESTING**

1. This registration provides for the possession, sale, repair, maintenance, service and testing of lasers.
2. The registrant shall be responsible for any employee, and the work carried out by that employee, during installations, repair, maintenance, service or testing of lasers at the registered premises or at any other location as if those premises were the principal registered premises.
3. The registrant is directed to ensure that —
  - 3.1 lasers are operated only by a person holding an appropriate licence under the Act or by persons acting under the direction and immediate personal supervision<sup>1</sup> of a licensee;
  - 3.2 lasers conform to Australian Standard AS2211-1991 titled “Laser Safety”;
  - 3.3 any laser equipment that is installed complies with the Schedules of the Radiation Safety (General) Regulations pertaining to the class of laser in question;
  - 3.4 no modifications are made to a laser or laser product or its installation which may result in its non-compliance with the Australian Standard, the Schedules of the regulations unless the registrant can provide written authorisation from the Council for the specific modifications required;
  - 3.5 all personnel involved with the operation of lasers are informed of laser safety issues and requirements<sup>2</sup>;

**Notes:**

<sup>1</sup> “immediate personal supervision” means that the licensee must be present and directly supervise the individual’s work.

<sup>2</sup> Regulations 18 and 19 of the Radiation Safety (General) Regulations 1983 require the Registrant and Radiation Safety Officer to ensure that safety training and instruction is given to all persons working with laser equipment on the premises.
