

RADIATION SAFETY ACT

CONDITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS (SECTION 36)

SALE OF PRESCRIBED ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS

1. This licence permits the holder, and persons under the direction and general supervision of the licensee, to sell* prescribed electronic products, the registration of which is required by the Radiation Safety Act. It does not permit the licensee to use, repair or maintain any of these products.
2. The licensee is directed to ensure that:-
 - 2.1 sales are made only to persons holding a licence under the Act related to the class of product which is to be sold, or to persons who are exempted from the requirement to hold a licence for the class of product to be sold.

NOTE: *ALL purchasers must register the product(s) and the premises where the product(s) will be used within 14 days of becoming the owner.*
 - 2.2 all sales are notified in writing to the Radiological Council forthwith and within seven (7) days of delivery to the purchaser.
 - 2.3 any prescribed electronic product sold complies with relevant Schedules of the Radiation Safety (General) Regulations 1983, any relevant amendment regulations, and any additional requirements that may from time to time be stipulated by the Radiological Council.
 - 2.4 if there are requirements prescribed under 2.3 and if the product(s) to be sold cannot comply with these requirements the supplier shall notify both the purchaser and the Radiological Council in writing and shall not supply the product to the purchaser without the approval in writing of the Council.
3. Conditions 2.3 and 2.4 also apply to second-hand prescribed electronic products.

* *sell is defined in Section 4(1) of the Act and includes loans, gifts, lease etc. Licensees should be familiar with the full requirements of this Section.*

Attention is also drawn to Section 29 of the Act, which states:-

- 29 (1) *A person who sells any radioactive substance, or any irradiating apparatus or electronic product, the registration of which is required under this Act, commits an offence unless:-*
- (a) he requires the purchaser to produce evidence that he is the holder of a licence or exemption granted under this Act and in relation thereto; and*
 - (b) he notifies the Council in writing forthwith specifying the name and address given by the purchaser and particulars of the relevant licence or exemption.*
