Preferred Examination Date

Examinations are usually held at 9.00 am on the second Wednesday of each month at the Radiation Health Section, 18 Verdun Street, Nedlands. Applications should be received at least 7 days in advance. The date selected may not be available and is therefore subject to change.

Fees

The examination fee is payable to the Radiological Council and must accompany the application. It is not refundable.

Eligibility for Examination

The examination is being conducted under the Radiation Safety (Qualifications) Regulations. A pass in the examination may be a pre-requisite for a licence to be granted under the Act, however, the Radiological Council may also require applicants to have first attended an approved radiation safety course relevant to their needs.

Persons who have attended radiation safety courses elsewhere should seek confirmation from the Council that the course will be accepted as a pre-requisite before applying for examination.
