

RADIATION SAFETY ACT

Legislation for the Service of Prescribed Electronic Products

This document provides an overview of legislation for individuals who have obtained a licence required under the Radiation Safety Act in Western Australia through the Mutual Recognition Act to service prescribed electronic products.

Radiation Safety Act

The service of prescribed electronic products in Western Australia is controlled under the Radiation Safety Act 1975 and its subsidiary legislation.

The Act provides for the approval of persons working with prescribed electronic products through the **licensing** of individuals and the **registration** of the premises and equipment. Registrations and licences are issued by the Radiological Council the statutory body created under the Act. Daily administration of the Act is handled by Radiation Health staff acting through the Secretary of the Council.

Conditions, Restrictions and Limitations

Licences and registrations are subject to conditions, restrictions and limitations imposed under Section 36 of the Act. For reference a copy of the conditions are attached to your personal licence as relevant.
